

CAT OWNER'S GUIDE TO BUILDING AN EMERGENCY EVACUATION CAT GO-BAG



Compile Crucial Documents

Photo with your cat, vet records, vaccination history, microchip details in waterproof container.

Pack Essential Sustenance

Food, Water, Medication:

- 7–14 days' worth for evacuation
- 30-day supply for shelter-in-place

Additional Items:

- Travel bowls
- Manual can opener

Emergency water packets

*Tag bag with cat's name and phone.
Refresh supplies twice yearly!*

Gather Medical Supplies

Full medication supply, extra parasite control, pet first aid kit with bandages, gauze, tick remover, paw ointments.

Add Comfort Items

Familiar toys, treats, Thunder Shirt, calming aids, blanket, cooling pads.

Prepare Safety Gear

Include disposable litter pans, cat litter, and pee pads. Have a sturdy carrier or collapsible crate ready, and pack a large pillowcase for quick cat transfers.
